Meeting Minutes were reviewed individually and approved.

The clubs financial position was not discussed to the constant changing that has gone on because of basket bingo which is going to occur on Saturday Feb 25th. The Financials will be discussed as usual in March.

- 1) Basket Bingo- is taking place in 2 days Feb 25th. If anyone still wants to make a cash donations please accept it.
 - a) Advanced ticket sales are going well about 120 sold to date
 - b) Basket Bingo expenses are \$1600.00
 - c) Donations so far \$1,200.00
 - d) Deb Krawice the Basket Bingo Committee chairperson reported, between the ticket sales and the donations the event is already in the Black with \$3,600.00 in income and \$1,600.00 in expenditures.
- 2) Canning- The dates for canning are as announced at January's meeting March 9th, 10th, and 11th. We need volunteers to go around to local businesses and get their permission to have participants can outside their stores.
- 3) Field Status – The fields will not be used until the Second week in April. This is so we can have them air-rated and seeded. Until then the games will be held at John E. Riely School fields.
 - a) The fields have some damaged sprinkler heads so repairs will begin as soon as it is warm enough to start
- 4) Training status – 2 teams will be training with United Soccer Academy, 4 teams will be training with Prem-Soccer, and 1 team will be training with Mikos Bogner
 - a) Veterans Park is available to our club on Tuesday and Friday evenings starting April 1st. Sunday Afternoons will also be available after mid June.
- 5) United Soccer Academy - will hold it training camps at Kenneth Ave. fields this year as usual. They are Spring Soccer Squirts, Summer Training Camp (last Week In August) and Fall Soccer Squirts
- 6) Coaches training went well last Sunday. The Training was extended and ran for 3 hours. That was to make up for the cancellation of the first scheduled day (canceled due to Blizzard)

- 7) Snack Stand – The floor has been poured and we were told at the February Recreation meeting that we would also be getting a full kitchen (that includes a Refrigerator and stove).
- 8) The Domain name for our web site is up in March and it must be renewed.
- 9) Lisa Krehan Scholarship information is up on the Mid New Jersey Youth Soccer Assn. web site, so please let the high school aged player know about it
- 10) South Plainfield Soccer Association has talked in the past about sponsoring a scholarship for a male and a female high school student. It was proposed to vote on an amount of the \$500.00 for each scholarship.
 - a) The vote passed unanimously (see the attendance sheet for results)
- 11) Westfield armory and other indoor soccer locations are starting to lower their price for field time so you can look at these places if you need a place for your team to practice.
- 12) Ice Packs and Other First Aid Supplies-Tracy Lundy has ice packs and other first aid supplies left over from last year when the club issued first aid kits. If you need refills please let her know what you need.
- 13) Uniform organizer Millie Hunt has resigned from this duty so if you want to take this on please contact Millie ASAP. She will explain how the process works
