

## South Plainfield Soccer Association Meeting Minutes

Meeting Minutes were reviewed individually and approved.

- 1) **Financials-** A handout was distributed. There was only one question regarding the financial handout. There was no deposit from Match Fit Academy. Al Vill stated that he would check with Match Fit to find out when we should see the donation.
- 2) **Field Status-** The fields are basically closed.
  - a) Field Day is July 8, Field 1 will be airraitted and seeded
  - b) The Sprinkler System (back flow preventor) was damaged by Vandals. Approximately 10 gallons per second flowed for 10 hours. The Police and the Water company were advised immediately upon discovery of the damage. The water company could not find the shut off valve so the water flowed for several hours while the shut off valve was located.
    - (1) The Township did receive a \$25,000.00 water bill.
    - (2) We will install a concrete pad and an enclosure over the water service
  - c) We will be looking into getting a backstop type of netting installed behind the goals
  - d) Spruce It Up recommended installing athletic sod around the goal mouth of field 1
- 3) **Training Status-**Coaches please let Al Vill know what your requirements for Fall training
  - a) PREM Soccer will under take the training for this coming season. If you want to use thee trainer that you had this past year you are welcome to but you have to work out the details
- 4) **Summer Camps-**Prem Soccer will be running camps the week of July 17 for U-9 and U-10 players each age group will be limited to 24 players. This limitation will ensure that all participants will get individual attention.
  - a) United Soccer Academy will run camps in August. South Plainfield Soccer Club does receive money for each person who participates in the USA Camps
- 5) **Snack Stand-** Ann Marie Seyffart is going to be the Snack Stand Committee Chair Person
  - a) Snack Stand Floor was sealed and Bonded
  - b) The Refrigerator and Stove were delivered
  - c) An auxiliary refrigerator was donated filled with Gator Aid and Water
- 6) **Team Formation-**Most of the teams are in the final stages of formation

- a) **Al Vill** will meet with the U-14 Girls, U-13/14 Boys and U-9 Girls on July 5<sup>th</sup> to organize a teams for these players
- 7) **South Plainfield Soccer Club Scholarship**-winners were (2 males) Steve Lindgren and Brian Kelly. The soccer club had originally planned on giving out 1 male and 1 female scholarship. Un-fortunately there was only one female applicant and she did not meet the minimum qualification so the female scholarship was given to the male runner up.
- 8) **Committees**-The committee list was circulated at the meeting. The Committees that do not have a chair person to run them will not operate next season.

  - b) Paul Baldassarre asked for a younger team coach or parent to step up and lean the canning committee. Paul will not be able to do it after this coming season
  - c) Fall Canning Dates are 9/14, 9/15, 9/16, 9/17
- 9) **Fall Registration**- is on July 17, 2006 Location to be announced.
  - a) All the required forms will be posted on the Web page
  - b) U-8 teams will cost less from this point forward ( due to money and the uncertainty of children's interest)
    - (1) U-8 teams will also get an inexpensive uniform to help offset the cost
- 10) **Nominations**-for 3 Board Positions were taken
  - a) President              Al Vill- Nominated by P. Flanagan second by P. Baldassarre  
                                  Al Accepted the Nomination but said he would only commit for 1 year and then re-evaluate after that
  - b) President              P Flanagan by Al Vill, Nomination Declined
  - c) Vice President Paul Seyffart- Nominated by A. Vill Second by P. Baldassarre
  - d) Secretary              Pat Flanagan Nominated by Al Vill second by Bill Butrico
  - e) A Vacant Vice President's Position was appointed to Ken Noll. This position will be up for election July 07.
- 11) **Next Meeting** will be July 20, 2006. Board Elections will take place then

**Non Agenda Item** Pat Flanagan introduced a Injury report which should be filled out by a coach when ever there is an injury requiring first aid. There was an incident a few years ago of a Player who broke his leg about six months after the injury the parents stated they had no help from the coach and there was nothing on record for the club to say that the injury ever occurred.

**Non Agenda Item** Pat Flanagan spoke on the difficult tryout season we experienced this year.
