



**South Plainfield Soccer Club
General Meeting Minutes - March 26, 2009**

Meeting called to order 7:49pm

Minutes from last months meeting reviewed. Minutes approved.

Introduction of all in attendance

Financials - Terry Ward provided current financial reports. Noted that the Comedy Night proceeds from ticket sales were not on the report. Approx. \$4000.00 made so far, not including the expenses of Police and Fireman fees.

Canning income \$1400.00 from first weekend. 5 games of referee checks are due to be cut. Paul Billich added that he will follow up on his lead at Sipersteins to see if we could get a better price on field paint. Financials were approved.

Field Status - Ken Noll spoke regarding fields. Lining is going well with Shane. Parts are ordered for one of the paint machines, Fields are in good shape. It was noted that the wooden dogs do not seem to be getting the job done. A second field day is being planned to instruct coaches in field lining and machine maintenance. Also, protocol in opening and closing fields. Bleachers on field 2 will either have to stay or be moved with about 30 people. Checking with Rec. Dept. to see if we might be able to get one of the old bleachers from behind the PAL. Last game on the field will be responsible for replacing dogs on the fields, corner flags back into boys bathroom and all garbage cans emptied. It is advised to get parents involved with the garbage. Keys should be ready in 1-2 weeks . It was suggested by Bob Cusick to look into Shared Services to come and rake the goose poop from the field.

Fundraising - Comedy Show, Saturday Night, March 28th. 170 tickets sold, will cut off at 200 per PAL and fire dept. If tickets are available, they will be sold \$30.00 at the door. BYOB, BYOF(food), 30 prizes to raffle and 50/50's to generate more income. 4:00pm set-up.

Canning - Approx. \$1400.00 from first weekend. 3 teams canned on 3/8, all no shows are rescheduled. 4-10 - Hotspurs, 4-11 - Hammertime, Spartans, 5-8 - Storm, 5-9 - Arsenal, Magic. The average can from this years canning netted \$55.00.

Super 50/50 - Chrissy Sanko was not present. Tickets will be ready any day and will be distributed before next meeting. Books of 10 tickets, \$5.00ea. 70% - 1st place, 20% - 2nd Place, 10% - 3rd. Prizes raffled on May 31st.
