



SPSC General Meeting Minutes June 24, 2010

Meeting Called to order - 7:45pm

Introductions

Review of May Meeting Minutes - Approved Joe Evans

Field Status: Bob Sanko spoke regarding sprinkler system repaired and working fine. A-Tech made repairs at no charge. Brown spots on fields near bleachers. Grass was also cut too low, Bob to speak with town. Looking to have another field day, a last chance for those needing to fulfill bond obligation. Paul Baldassare asked how his U-19's could satisfy the bond. Bob suggested that the older kids spend 2 hours with the younger teams during training/practice to "mentor". Will put this in place this spring.

Trainig/Camps: Bill Garner spoke regarding the Red Bulls training and the need to choose our trainer. Looking to set this up and have coaches involved in the selection process. As to the camps, there was no current count for the camps, will look into that as well. Dawn H stated that she has advertised the camps in the Observer, sent out emails to the membership and listed the camps on the town website. Bill has Red Bulls posters to put up in stores/businesses that parents would see. Also suggested a rec mailing. Paul Baldassare inquired if the club knew of the amp being run by the high school coach, Perfillio. Thought it would be great to have an alliance. This has been attempted and we will revisit this to build a better bond between the club and the high school.

Team/League Issues: Phil Battista was not in attendance, Dawn H covered this topics. Currently 99% of the incoming players have been contacted, with the balance to be completed by 6/24/10. We have 11 (or 12) teams registering for the Fall season. Phil is also working on obtaining tirt time for August practices, will advise once Kevin Hughes completes the schedule,

Financials: Dawn F was not in attendance due to an emergency. Financials were not available at the meeting. Will update at next meeting.

Public Relations/On Line Registration: Dawn H spoke regarding the ongoing articles in the Observer. Mostly coverage of the camps and registration, kick off, field duty will be run at this point since we are not currently playing. The Kickoff is being planned, need

to find a date , which will need to be done working around Pop Warner, SPJBC, Labor Day etc. Looking for the weekend prior to our season opening. Bob and Phil looking into our entertainment, Bill Garner has committed to BBQ, asked if anyone has any connections to let us know as we would like to once again be able to offer this KickOff free of charge to our members. Dawn H also spoke of this years scholarship winners, James Seyffart and Jenna Heckel and read their essays. This was a way of illustrating to our coaches, board members and parents in attendance just how much of an impact we make on our players, on and off the field.

Dawn H also spoke regarding the On-Line registration being up and running, as well as a tentative date for Live registration being July 8th. Will confirm that once we have the updated paperwork from the league. Dawn stressed the importance of the On Line registration and how it will help the club administratively, enabling us to spend more time in other areas, since the system will do many things for us, generating reports, rosters, etc. Pete Goitandia had many questions regarding the security of the system, ownership of the program, etc. which was deferred to a later date for answers.

Open Issues: Paul Baldassare reminded the club that the Old Timers Motorcycle event is held on October 3rd. We will need to schedule accordingly. Laura Readie inquired who the Super 50/50 winners were: Diane Gazzara, Gerri Akpan and (Mark Scott?). Club made apprx. \$1300.00 per Bob Sanko on the 50/50. Bob Sanko asked those in attendance if they wanted to go back to a team weekend assignment for Snackstand coverage.. Most agree that it is the simplest way to ensure coverage. Bob also inquired whether teams wanted to continue participating in the Laine's Angels(Kicks for Kids) event at St Joe's. It was agreed that based on league assignment of home games that weekend it would be left to the individual teams whether they want to participate and move their game to St Joe's. Steve Balenger asked if the club knew anything about a Nike sponsored 5 v 5 tournament or a MidNJ Summer League. No one was aware. Dawn H asked if Steve could find out more about these and bring us information. Also asked Bill Garner to look into as part of training and camps. Landi spoke regarding the Labor Day parade, need to get all league paperwork in order prior to the town paperwork, to ensure insurance coverage for the float. Landi will chair and look into this as well. Paul Baldassare also inquired about insurance coverage while practicing during the off season. All insurance questions were deferred to Dawn F to review policy and advise.
